# Possible changes to your refuse and recycling collection day



Your current waste and recycling collection calendar expires by 27 March 2009. When you receive your new calendar there may be some changes to the day your waste is collected. The way we collect your refuse and recycling and the types of waste we collect will not change.

### Why the possible change to your collection day?

In order to increase the efficiency of the collection rounds, we are looking at the service we provide in the North Shropshire area and are planning to re-route some of the waste collection vehicles. This will enable us to provide a more efficient service to all our residents in the area.

### How will this affect me?

For some residents your collection day may remain the same, for others the day may change. However, the time of collection may still change so please remember to continue to have your containers **available for collection by 7.00am.**

### When will I find out more?

You will receive your new waste and recycling collection calendar through the post at the end of March giving more details about your individual dates for collection. Please check to see if your day of collection has changed and keep this calendar safe and refer to it throughout the year – it will also contain important information about Easter and Bank Holiday changes.










